8. The department of Library automated by the institution for better services to students with advance software 'LIBSOFT' and to provided accessible repository through 'OPAC' to students. On the other hand, the department of Library took subscription of 'INFLIBNET Centre' for not only teachers but also students.
9. For undergraduate students, the college has an effective NSS unit. The NSS unit organises awareness programmes on issues such as general and mental health, human rights, gender sensitization, health camps such as blood donation camps, youth empowerment programmes, cleanliness drives, and tree planting drives. Some of these activities will necessitate community

involvement. These activities help students develop their personalities, increase their self-esteem, build their confidence, make them socially aware of current societal issues, and practically empower them to deal with larger societal issues and problems. They also develop a sense of gratitude and debt to the institution, as well as respect for society.

Various best practises are being implemented in the college in order to instill social, ethical, moral, and environmental consciousness values in students in order to make them better and more responsible citizens of tomorrow.
