- Provide information to Sericulture farmers about new high yielding hybrids of Silkworm and mulberry plants.


The above goals will be accomplished by undertaking the following activities:

Brief report	<p>During the academic year 2017 – 18, total 15 students were enrolled for 'Certificate course in Sericulture'. The lectures were on Friday and Saturday morning 8am to 10am and the practical were based on the silkworm rearing schedule. Students reared silkworms during the months September- October in college campus and gain 3kg of cocoon. This production of cocoon was preserved by oven drying.</p> <p>Study tour - During this session study tour was organized on 19 August 2017 at Basic Seed Multiplication and Training Centre (BSMTC), Central Sericulture Board, Devlipar and Mohadi Dist. Bhandara. The main aim of tour was to encourage and update the knowledge of students about Tasar Silkworm rearing, cocoon reeling, weaving and to study animal and plant diversity. Students observed storage, mating, egg laying of moths of wild Tasar silkworms rearing.</p> <p>In village Mohadi, which is near about 15 km from Devlipar, students observed and learned to prepare silk thread by reeling procedure as well as weaving silk sarees on handloom. The main aim of tour was to encourage and update the knowledge of students about Tasar Silkworm rearing. The teaching faculties Dr. A. D. Tiple, Head of the Zoology Department, Dr. Karuna P. Ganvir and Dr. Khushal Pathade were present in this tour with students.</p> <p>During this certificate course, student also visited farmer's field on 5th December at Zadshi, Tah. Seloo, where they learned how to rear the mulberry silkworms on large scale.</p>



Annual Report 2021-22

During this session 2021-22, classes for Certificate course in Sericulture started from 1st August 2021 to 31st January 2022 on every Friday and Saturday in morning 9am to 10 am. The number of students admitted for this course were 15. For practical session students visit was organised to the farmer's field intermittently.

During this session the students of Certificate course visited to the Sericulture farm situated in Tahasil Seloo (Ghorad), Dist. Wardha. The Sericulture farmer Mr. Viki Mahure explained in detail about all the methods, schedule and techniques to be followed in Sericulture. On the day of visit of students, Viki Mahure had harvested 1.48 tan of cocoons. He also demonstrated the harvesting of cocoons from chandrika and explained for identification of defective or double cocoons. Students of B.Sc final year students learned all sericulture techniques in detail.
