

ADMISSION RULES

1. Admission processes of the college are as per Affiliated University i.e. RTMNU, Nagpur Schedule.
2. Candidates will obtain application forms from the college office and after duly filling it, submit the same before the last date.
3. The candidates will be interviewed for admission. They must be personally present before the admission committee at the time of interview with their original certificates, get admission recommended and get their signatures attested. Admission will be granted on depositing original transfer certificate and character certificate. Identity card of the College will be completely filled along with admission application form and the same will be given to the candidates as soon as he deposits the fee. For girl students, separate Committees will be formed if the number of girl applicants are substantial.
4. The candidates whose admission is sanctioned will have to deposit the prescribed fee within the prescribed period on the extension counter in the College. Failure to do so will lead to automatic cancellation of the admission. In case of failure to get admission in a particular faculty, the same admission form may not be used for admission to another faculty. Time table will be pasted on the notice board immediately after the last date of admission and teaching shall commence accordingly.
5. It is compulsory for each student to carry identity card. Entry to the college campus without identity card is prohibited.
6. To prevent misuse of the identity card, the arrangement has been made that in case of loss of the identity card, the student concerned will submit an application with affidavit to the Proctorial Board to this effect. The Proctorial Board will make a detailed inquiry and issue a second copy of the identity card after Rs 50 have been deposited. If a student is caught with a forged identity card, the college administration will initiate disciplinary and legal action against the student.
7. Change of faculty and subjects will be allowed conditionally.
8. Reservation quota as per Govt. of Maharashtra rules for SCs is 13%, for STs 7%, For OBCs 19%, 2% SBC, Nomadic Tribes(A,B,C,D) NT-A(Vimukta Jati)-3%, NT-B(Banjara)- 2.5%, NT-C (Dhangar)3.5%, NT-D(Vanjari), Maratha Caste 16% (68% Total) based on local demographics.
